- *Carewins Ltd v Bright Fortune Ltd* Hong Kong Court of Final Appeal: claim against a carrier for misdelivery of goods without production of the original bill of lading.
- *Tradepower (Holdings) Ltd v Tradepower Ltd* [2010] 1 HKC 380 Hong Kong Court of Final Appeal: claim for transfer of property with an alleged intention to defraud creditors.
- *Goldlion Properties Ltd v Regent National Enterprises Ltd* Hong Kong Court of Final Appeal: claim for specific performance of a contract for the sale of the Kimberley Hotel, Hong Kong.
- *Dragon Point Holdings Ltd v Heath Lambert (Hong Kong) Ltd* Hong Kong High Court, Commercial List: claim arising from constructive total loss of vessel.
- *Akai Holdings Limited & Others v Ho Wing On & Others* Hong Kong High Court, Commercial List: claim for an amount exceeding US\$500 million for alleged breach of fiduciary duty arising from one of Hong Kong's largest ever corporate collapses.
